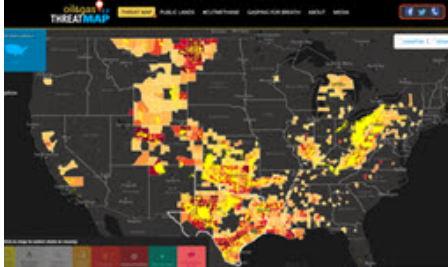
Drone surveillance of regional fracking sites in NM

The River Healers have droned multiple fracking sites in the Greater Chaco Area impacted by explosions, fires, spills, and methane. [Read more](#)



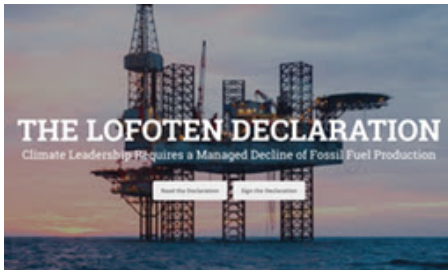
